

Temporary Rifle Range Safety Process

Until the red warning lights and horns are upgraded and re-installed, a manual warning process is required. The use of this system is required by all who utilize the range.

1. Prior to stepping in front of the firing line, ask all shooters to empty their firearms and secure the bolt.
2. Once all firearms are verified safe and the line is in a “safe” condition, move forward of the center of the firing line and place the warning cone and flag on the upper portion of the grass.
3. Proceed forward to place/replace targets, etc.
4. Upon return to the firing line, place the cone back under the covered area behind the line and return the line to “hot” status.

While the line is in “safe” condition and the cone/flag is forward of the firing line, no firearms, ammo or gear shall be handling at the firing line. NO EXCEPTIONS
